Collections

 - Family Events (One-day events for general admission, assist activities, direct visitors to facilities, communication)
 - KidSpace Outreach Program (Bring activities to air shows along the Front Range)
 - Wings Aerospace Science Program (Assist in building or restocking trunks of physics curriculum)

Facilities

Hands-on jobs require basic or extensive mechanical skills.

- Operations (Open and/or close the Museum)
- Building Maintenance (Perform general maintenance and upkeep for the hangar)
- Avionics (Design and build the exhibit and facilitate HAM radio)
- Cleaning (Clean floors, dust exhibits, clean airplanes)
- Restorations (Restore aircraft and/or artifacts - skilled labor required.)
